# Bowls Kapiti Coast Men's & Women's Pennants Conditions of Play

**Division 1** (no entry limit) 8 players per side (2 teams of fours)

**Division 2** (no entry limit)

Men: 8 players per side (2 teams of fours) Women: 6 players per side (2 teams of Triples)

**Division 3** (no entry limit)

Men: 6 players per side (2 teams of Triples)

Triples: 15 ends, 3 bowls, no time limit.

Fours: 18 ends, no time limit.

#### The Laws of the Sport of Bowls will apply to all games

Two games per day. Report 9.00 am, start 9.30 am
If first game is not finished by 12.30pm it is to be completed after the second game has been completed.

#### Winners will be determined by:

Three points for a win and one point for a draw.

One bonus point awarded for a win by seven shots or more.

One bonus point awarded for a loss of three shots or less.

If sides are equal on points at the conclusion of the competition, shot differential will apply. If still equal then shots will apply.

#### **Player Eligibility**

Players must be full playing members of the Club they are playing for.

#### **Defaults & Forfeits**

Any defaulted or forfeited games will result in the non-offending team receiving the match points available. The score will be recorded as 1 shot to nil. No bonus points will be awarded.

Where a team has two sides in a division and those sides are playing each other, no points will be awarded should one team default of forfeit a game.

#### Weather interruption

Where any game is stopped because of inclement weather and cannot be resumed, the available match points for that game are to be divided equally between the Clubs.

Where a round is postponed prior to the start of play that round will be played on a spare day. If there are no spare days available, or previous postponed rounds have already been allocated to the spare day(s), that round will be abandoned and **no points will be awarded**.

Note: All divisions are to be run independently of each other (i.e. inclement weather in the Northern area of the Centre may not affect the Southern area and vice versa.

## **Appeals**

The Centre Tournament Committee will adjudicate all appeals.

### Catering

All players are required to pay \$1 to the host club to cover catering costs.

## **Penalty for Non Attendance**

Where a team entered fails to turn up at the event, or is withdrawn by the Club with less than five (5) days notice, a penalty of \$50 (incl GST) will be imposed on the Club.

### **Use of Greens**

Greens being used for a Centre event cannot also be used for any other event during the period of use by the Centre.
