EVENT CONDITIONS OF PLAY

EVENT STRUCTURE:

- 1) The event consists of two tournaments, Men's & Women's, with each team consisting of fourteen (14) players, with two (2) sides of seven (7) players.
- 2) Each team shall contain two sides of seven (7) players which may be titled at the sides' discretion ("A" & "B", Black & White, or any similar identifiers) which will be grouped into two fixed pools of sides.
- 3) Each side will include Single, Pairs and Fours disciplines without changes permitted between disciplines and sides.
- 4) There will be three (3) rounds of 'round-robin' play using a 'scattered draw' with the "A sides" vs "A sides" and "B sides" vs "B sides" in each discipline.
- 5) Each tournament will be determined by the aggregate score of both sides.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY & FORMAT

6) Format

Singles 21 shots

Pairs 3 bowls - 18 ends Fours 2 bowls - 15 ends

Time limit 2 ½ hours for all disciplines

7) Start times: 8:30am Welcome, orientation and house-keeping.

First Round 9am 8:45am for trial ends
Second Round 12:15pm (or earlier if practical)
Third Round 3pm (or earlier if practical)

Morning tea available from 8:15am

Lunch break after 1st round, afternoon tea as practical. Lunches may be ordered if required or players may bring their own.

- 8) Match Points:- Win = 2pt, Draw = 1pt, Loss = 0pt.
 Winners determined by most points or, if even, then by differential over all three rounds, and then by most 'shots for' over all rounds.
- 9) All Centres' team lists are required (for publication purposes) to be with BKC by Monday 25th Jan 2021. Changes to teams to be presented to the Event Controller prior to Round 1 in written form.
- 10) Players may not change between squads. While player positions may be changed within a discipline, players cannot move between disciplines

All games will follow the Laws of the Sport of Bowls, the Bowls NZ standard regulations & Bowls Kapiti Coast standard conditions as described in the Core Conditions of Play on the Bowls Kapiti Coast Inc website under "Representative Events" beneath the "Events & Results" tab on the Homepage, and are supplementary as per Bowls NZ 'Regulation 10 - National Events'

- providing they are relevant to Representative Events
- are not over-ridden by specific terms in these Event Condition of Play
- and in the case of ambiguity or conflict of meaning, then these Event CoP take precedence.

STANDARD PROTOCOLS & ETIQUETTE

- a) The Controlling Body have the right to amend the times when deemed necessary.
- b) Trial ends 15min before 1st round of the day <u>or</u> after a change of Green.

 Trials ends are 'up & back' and to be completed by 8:55am (or 5min before a round starts on a changed Green).
- c) A 'coin-toss' for each game is to be made by the disciplines' Skips' at the beginning of each round to determine who has the lead decisions.
- d) A joint managers/selectors meeting after the 1st round (plan for during Round 2) will confirm conditions & format for next year.
- e) In the case of inclement weather the Controlling Body may alter conditions and time limits. (Laws 55.3.4)
- f) Event Controllers, Host Representatives, Recorders, Umpires and Markers' names will be on display at the venues and published in advance if practical.
- g) Greens and Green selections are conditional if published in the Draw and subject to changes due to environmental conditions on the day. Greens will not be changed between rounds unless required by condition or weather.
- Smoking is not permitted on/near the Green during an event. Other restrictions are as per the host clubs requirements.
- Players and spectators cell phones should be set on 'silent' while any play is in progress. If it is necessary to respond to a call, players are requested to leave the green.
- Postponements will be on the BKC Website.
