During the game of Bowls as Umpires are moving about the green – but not when answering an “Umpire” call – it is at this time that umpires are often questioned about aspects of the Laws of the Sport of Bowls. Umpires are only too pleased to answer and discuss such questions and interpret the Law(s) for bowlers. Yet, there are many bowlers who think that they know “the Laws”, but regularly in discussion with such bowlers the umpire ascertains that the bowler has misinterpreted the Law, or is not aware that the Law has been amended.

One objective of the Umpires Association is to achieve uniformity and consistency amongst umpires in the interpretation and application of the laws. At each Umpires Association meeting, topical issues, unusual incidents, and, recent judicial (from World Bowls and Bowls New Zealand) decisions are discussed. Our purpose is not only to ensure umpires are kept up-to-date with events but also ensure a consistency in the application of the laws. All bowlers and representatives from Clubs are very welcome to attend these meetings.

The Umpires Association extends a welcome to all bowlers to attend umpires’ meetings at either the Levin or Waikanae venues at which there is usually strong discussion about the interpretation of the laws.

I, and my fellow Umpires, wish all bowlers, their clubs and the Centre an enjoyable and successful season.

COACHING

I spoke last season about the new structure Bowls New Zealand had implemented and unfortunately my concerns have shown to be correct. The training courses are hard to organise and our Centre, along with Wellington, Wanganui and Manawatu, have run only one this past season. We were fortunate that one new coach from our Centre was able to attend the course and obtained his qualifications.

7 current coaches have been reaccredited during the year for a further 2 years and this enables them to continue on working with their club members. We have at present 20 current coaches, 1 trainee coach and 5 Foundation Coaches. These people are the backbone of their clubs and are often the first people that spend time with new members introducing them to our game. I would like to thank them all for the time and effort they put into running very successful coaching sessions at their respective clubs.

I have not been able to run a talent development programme this past year because of lack of numbers but I have been working closely with the 8's and 5' years and under Women, who have been doing very well in the representative fixtures. I hope, along with a couple of other coaches, to extend this training next season, to **all** Centre bowlers who are 8 years and under who wish to further their development of the game.

Last year I advised the Centre that I would like to step away from the role of Coaching Convenor but unfortunately no one was willing to take on this role and as it is an important part of our centre's requirements I have continued but would like at some stage for someone to put their hand up!

On behalf of all the coaches, thank you the members, who are willing to learn and listen and support us in our endeavours to make the game more enjoyable for you all.

DUTIES OF A MARKER

Section 14 - Law 55

The Marker shall:

- (i) Centre the Jack and place a full length Jack 2m from the front ditch in compliance with Law 22.2.
- (ii) Ensure that the Jack is a minimum of 23m from the mat line after it has been centred.
- (iii) Stand to one side of the rink and at least 2m to the rear of the Jack.
- (iv) Answer any specific question relating to the existing state of the head while the player is in possession of the rink, and when requested, clearly indicate the shot if possible.
- (v) Mark all 'touchers' immediately they come to rest, and remove chalk marks from 'non-touchers'. With the agreement of both Opponents, the Marker shall remove all 'dead bowls' from the green and ditch. The marker shall mark the positions of the Jack and 'touchers' which are in the ditch (See Law 24.4 and 29.2).
- (vi) Protect the head from any disturbance by outside objects.
- (vii) Not move, or cause to be moved, either Jack or bowls until each player has agreed to the number of shots.
- (viii) Measure carefully all doubtful shots when requested by either player. If unable to come to a decision satisfactory to the players, the Marker shall call in an Umpire whose decision shall be final.
- (ix) The marker shall enter the score at each end, and shall intimate to the players, the state of the game. When the game is finished, the Marker shall see that the scorecard containing the names of the Opponents is signed by them and disposed of in accordance with the rules of the competition.
- (x) The Marker shall remove the mat from the previous end if necessary.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

The following conditions of play will apply to all Bowls NZ and Centre Open Events. Other conditions in respect of format, venues, length of game etc., are stipulated for each individual event pages 24 - 32.

1. All events will be played under World Bowls 'Laws of the Sport of Bowls' Crystal Mark 1/3rd Edition and incorporated Bowls NZ Domestic Regulations.
2. Footwear and Clothing - Regulation 11 apply to all Centre events (including those events organised by Clubs on behalf of the Centre). Players in Singles and members of Teams must wear garments of the same colour/design as determined by the Tournament Controlling Body. Failure to comply will result in the offending Team or Side being defaulted for each round until they comply. (It is acknowledged that in the case of inclement weather, variations in wet weather gear can be difficult to avoid).
3. **Trial Ends.** Before the start of play in any game, or before continuing an unfinished game on another day, one trial end must be played in each direction. Trial ends must be completed by 8.55am. Play will commence at 9.00am unless otherwise advised. Players MAY have Trial ends where permitted, but these are to be completed 5 minutes prior to a Singles player or Teams 1st game of the day. **Absentee players not in attendance 10 minutes after the scheduled start of play,** will be defaulted unless otherwise determined by the Controlling Body.
4. **Practice.** If a player or team has a 'bye' in any round of a competition, the player or team can practice on a rink other than the rink which the player or team has been draw to play later that day, as long as the Controlling Body gives approval.
5. Composite Teams are permitted but it shall be the responsibility of the Skip entering the team to ensure and certify that each player is an active playing Member of a Club affiliated to Bowls NZ. In the event of a Composite Team winning an event, no Club Certificate will be awarded.
6. All bowls used in these events must show a stamp of '1982' or later.
7. Use of Adhesive Stickers - World Bowls 'Laws of the Sport of Bowls', Law 52.1.8 applies - If adhesive stickers are to be used in a team or Side game, then all members of that Team or Side must use the same design and colour of sticker. It is the responsibility of Clubs in the case of Club teams and the Skips for teams in Open events, to ensure that all Team members comply.
8. Dead end in time limit games - if in a time limit game the jack has been delivered before the time signal, the end continues. If it is subsequently made,

It must be replayed until it is completed. Ends made dead, must be replayed in accordance with Law 20 of the Laws of the Sport.

9. The Controlling Body shall have the right to include provisions of Appendix A-4 of the Laws of the Sport of Bowls 'Movement of players during play'.

(a) After delivering their first bowl, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head under the following circumstances:

1. **Singles Game:**

The opponents: after delivery of their third & fourth bowls.

2. **Pairs Game** (each player playing three bowls):

The **Leads** after delivery of their third bowl; the **Skips**; after delivery of their second & third bowls.

3. **Triples Game** (each player playing two bowls):

The **Leads** after delivery of their second bowl; the **Seconds**; after delivery of their second bowl; the **Skips**; after delivery of each of their bowls.

4. **Fours Game**

The **Leads** after the second player in their team has delivered their second bowl; the **Seconds**; after delivery of their second bowl; the **Thirds**; after delivery of their second bowl; the **Skips**; after delivery of each of their bowls.

(b) In exceptional and limited circumstances, a Singles player can ask the Marker for permission to walk up to the head, or a Skip can ask that a player walks up to the head earlier than described in Appendix A.4.1.

10. Event Format:

(a) All games will be played under the traditional format as below:

1. Singles: 21 shots, no time limit.
2. Pairs: 3 bowls per player. 18 Ends, no time limit.
3. Triples: 2 bowls per player. 18 Ends, no time limit.
4. Fours: 16 Ends, no time limit.

11. Variation of Programmes - if the particular circumstances are not already provided for in these conditions of play, the Controlling Body shall have the power to alter or amend the programme as provided in Law 55.3.4.

12. **Uncompleted Games -**

i **Section Play - Sections played on one day over 3 rounds - 2/3 winners qualifying.**

- all Sections will run independently of each other

- in the event of a qualifying round within a Section not being completed because of inclement weather conditions and the Controlling Body Committee declares further play will not be possible, then the round for that section will be void.

- where 1 or 2 Rounds have already been completed and further rounds are declared void, then all winners qualify.
- where it is not possible to complete any round **ALL** teams will proceed to Post Section play.

- Interclub** - Should inclement weather or any other circumstances so require, the Controlling Body is authorised to regard a minimum of **FIVE** completed rounds as a concluded competition. Any game that has not been completed because of inclement weather conditions that prevent further play, will be abandoned and any result for that round will be void.
- Substitutes will only be allowed in accordance with Bowls NZ Regulation Clause 7. An Application Form (page 22) must be completed prior to the event commencing and approval obtained from the Tournament Convenor as per the instructions on page 19.
 - Completion of the Scorecard is the responsibility of the **Skip** who shall complete it in full and ensure it is signed on completion of the game in accordance with Law 40.1.7.
 - Entry Fees - no refund will be made to entrants who withdraw within 10 (ten) days before the event, or to Tournament defaulters.
 - No smoking is permitted on the Green during an event. Smokers are required to observe the Clubs policy and utilise the Smoking area provided. Where a player fails to comply with this requirement, the Controlling Body will issue a warning through the Skip of the Team. If the player continues to offend, play will be suspended for the duration of that Game and the Game will be forfeited to the opposition.
 - Players and Spectators Mobile phones should be set to **'Silent'** whilst any play is in progress. Where it is necessary to respond to a call, players are requested to leave the green.

USE OF GREENS

On no account must a green which is being used for a Centre Tournament, be used for any other event or play during the period of use by the Centre.

DEFINITIONS

- (a) **OPEN:** Means a Tournament which is open to any bowler who is a full member of any Bowling Club affiliated to Bowls New Zealand.
- (b) **JUNIOR:** A man or woman player whose playing membership of a bowling club does not exceed a total of five years. The membership year runs from 1st July in any year to 30th June in the following year.
- (c) **DEVELOPMENT PLAYER:** A man or woman player whose playing membership of a bowling club does not exceed a total of ten years. The membership year runs from 1st July in any year to 30th June in the following year.
- (d) **VETERAN:** A player aged 65 years of age (or older) who will, on attaining the age of 70, be presented with a Veterans Badge, if playing in the Centre's Veteran's Tournament.

CONDITIONS FOR CHAMPION OF CHAMPION EVENTS

1. Each constituent club shall be entitled to one entry to each of the Champion of Champions Fours, Triples, Pairs, Singles, Junior Singles (Men & Women).
2. The players to represent their club shall be found in open competition by their club in a fair and equitable manner.
3. Clubs shall notify the Centre office the names of the participants as soon as possible after the Club event has been completed or **at least one week prior** to the competition, or, in the case that the event has not been completed, an indication that the Club will be participating.
4. **SUBSTITUTES AND REPLACEMENTS**
See Bowls NZ **REGULATION 7/** Approval of the proposed Substitute/Replacement must be obtained from the Tournament Convenor as soon as the need has been established. An Application Form for use when applying for a Substitute/Replacement appears on page 22 of this Handbook.
5. If illness or injury occurs as late as the evening prior to the event, the Tournament Convenor must be notified and approval given for the proposed substitute. The completed application form is to be handed to the Tournament Controller prior to the start of play.
6. Should a member of two clubs win the same discipline in their Club Championships, they can only represent one Club at the Champion of Champion event and this will be the Club they won at first. Substitutes are not permitted, therefore the second Club will not be represented at Champion of Champion level.

"In cases where a team entered by a Club in a Pennants, Interclub, Champion of Champions, Godfrey Bowen Mixed Masters, Executive Fours, Mexted Cup, Seddon Shield, Carrell Knight or Bill Gibbons Trophy event, fails to turn up at the event or is withdrawn by the Club with less than five (5) days notice to the Centre prior to the date of the event, a fine of \$50 (inc. GST) may be imposed on the Club."

PLURAL MEMBERSHIP - Regulation 5 - Regulation revoked

A player who is a member of more than one Club, can now play for any Club he/she is a member of in any competition. He/she can now be selected to represent any Centre in representative play that he/she is a member of. The restrictions that previously applied under this regulation no longer apply to competition at any level unless specifically identified in the Conditions for the event.

Clubs will be permitted to re-select sides between each round. Where there is a need to introduce replacements or substitutes between rounds, Clubs are to ensure that any side is not strengthened appreciably and that they be within the spirit of the Competition i.e. wherever possible, players that have played in Premier Div I or Premier Div II should not be used as replacements or substitutes in this Grade. Players cannot move between sections.

In any unforeseen circumstance, players from these Grades may be used as substitute/replacements if needed for the Premier Div I or Premier Div II. However, any such substitute/ replacement must be in accordance with Bowls NZ Regulation 7 and must be approved by the Controlling body prior to the commencement of the round.

Club sides may be re-selected after each round of the Competition. When replacements and substitutes are introduced between rounds, Clubs are to ensure that any side is not strengthened appreciably and that they be within the spirit of the competition. The Centre Tournament Committee will adjudicate all appeals. Substitutes and replacements are to be advised to the Host Club Umpire.

All Players are required to pay \$1.00 per person to the Host Club to cover catering.

Men's Divisions 1 & 2 and Women's Division 1 consist of two Fours teams. Sections will be made up of 6 or more Club sides. Women's Divisions 2 & Men's Division 3 will consist of two Triples teams playing 3 bowl triples.

Each round will comprise 4 games with each team playing 2 games per day. Morning Games commence 9.30am. Afternoon Games must commence by 1.00pm.

NOTE: Any morning game not completed by 12.30pm, will be finished at the end of the afternoon game.

Morning game – A team v B team, B team v A team.

Afternoon game – A team v A team, B team v B team.

All games 18 ends Fours, 15 ends Triples - no time limit.

Clubs may change players between morning and afternoon games. 3 points for a Win, 1 for a Draw. An additional two points for the side with the highest overall aggregate points (within the same round - ie: am and pm games) score 1 point to each Club for a tie.

.Any defaults will result in the non-defaulting team receiving the match points only - aggregate points **will not be** awarded. Where a Club has more than one team in the same division and those teams are playing each other, no points will be allocated should one team default.

Uncompleted Games:

Where any game is stopped because of inclement weather and cannot be resumed, the available match points for that game are to be divided equally between the clubs. The first time a Round is postponed prior to play, that Round is to be played on the spare day if allocated. If any subsequent Round is cancelled prior to play, and no additional Spare Day has been allocated, **no points will be awarded.**

All Players are required to pay \$1.00 per person to the Host Club to cover catering.

DUTIES OF THE HOST CLUB FOR INTERCLUB AND PENNANTS

Host Club to be responsible for appointing an Umpire, a Recorder and Markers where required. Host Clubs are to prepare scorecards (one set) for each game and are to instruct Skips and Markers that these are to be completed in full (including players' names) and be signed as correct by the opposing skip or player. The scorecards on completion of play are to be handed to the Host Club recorder for compilation of the Official Results Chart.

The Centre will provide the Host Club with Official Draw and Results Charts in advance of playing dates. **The Host Club Recorder is to record the result of the Game only** - compilation of Points and Aggregate scores will be the responsibility of the Centre Interclub/Pennants Coordinator.

Host Club is to deliver or email the Results Chart to the Centre Interclub/Pennants Coordinator or to the Centre Office no later than noon on the day following play- alternatively the results should be telephoned through to the nominated Centre Official and then a copy of the results chart should be posted to the Centre office as soon as possible.

The Host club is to retain their copy of the Official Draw and Results Chart together with the completed scorecards until the completion of the Pennants Tournament in case they need to be referred to in the event of any dispute or appeal.

A Centre Standings Chart for each Division will be circulated as soon as possible after completion of each day of Interclub/Pennants and these will appear on the Centre website as soon as updated results are available. Clubs can assist the Centre Pennants Coordinator by bringing to that persons attention, any error or irregularity that appears in such Standing Charts.

In the event of inclement weather prompting a Host Club to cancel or delay play on their greens on any day, they should contact the Centre Tournament Convenor (or nominated official) no later than 7.15am on the day. The Centre Interclub/Pennants Coordinator may, if it is considered appropriate, attempt to relocate that Grades play to an alternative venue. The Centre or Host Club will endeavour to have any cancellation or change broadcast on the usual radio stations as soon as possible. The Centre Interclub/Pennants Coordinator or Host Club will contact a participating Club Interclub/Pennants Coordinator in the event of any matter needing to be discussed or advised.
